1. Generic

SCOPE OF WORK

THIRD PARTY INSPECTION OF MATERIALS

Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd. is a Govt. of India Undertaking manufacturing Phenol, Acetone & Hydrogen Peroxide in its plant at Kochi, Kerala, India. We do procure various materials belonging to mechanical, electrical, Instrumentation items etc from across the country for the maintenance and operation of our unit. HOCL invites e-tender for finalizing the contract for the Inspection of items purchased by HOCL at suppliers/ sub-suppliers works. The inspection comprises of visual, dimensional, physical, functional, analytical, electrical, mechanical and non-destructive examination of large variety of items.

The scope of work shall include as under

- 1) Visual, dimensional and stage wise inspection wherever necessary and final inspection which includes witnessing of performance/Calibration tests as per the purchase orders/work orders, approved drawings & QAP etc. No Inspection shall be carried out without approved Quality Plan.
- 2) The inspection agency shall ensure the use of valid and calibrated measuring instruments and equipments.
- 3) Clear stamping of materials for acceptance and tagging for identification.
- 4) The accepted items shall be identified with unique seal / stamp and location of the samples hall be mentioned in the Inspection Reports.
- 5) Verifying the materials test certificate and other certificates as per the purchase orders /work orders, approved drawings & QAP etc. and checking of the related stamping on the materials.
- 6) Submission of the final inspection report in duplicate to us and the vendor along with all the documents like test certificates, guarantee certificates, material test certificate and any other documents mentioned in the purchase order,
- 7) Submission of fortnightly reports of purchase orders which are inspected by the TPIA. Reason for any delay has to be intimated to us in advance for taking the corrective actions.
- 8) TPI shall carryout inspection within 3 to 4 days notice by HOCL or the supplier directly. If the proposed Inspection date is beyond 3 to 4 days then the call has to be attended on the proposed date. However in exceptional cases, TPIA may have to attend the inspection call at short notice, for which necessary requests may be made by HOCL or suppliers directly.

For all the Inspection activities of HOCL the TPIA shall entrust the same work with their surveyors only and inspection through free lancers are not acceptable for HOCL inspection works.

Approval by HOCL shall not absolve the Bidder of their responsibility for ensuring completion and correctness of inspection and timely attending the calls. It will be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that approved, competent and suitable surveyors are only employed for Inspection of HOCL jobs.

Mode of Operation:

- a) You will carry out the pre-dispatch inspection of materials on HOCLs behalf at supplier's site based on specifications, relevant standards mentioned in our Purchase Order/Work Order, approved drawings & QAP etc.. However, TPIA shall inform the supplier the scope of your inspection well in advance and the documents to be submitted by the vendor at the time of inspection.
- b) We will forward one copy of Purchase Order to your office or your branch office concerned either in hard copy or through soft copies vide emails and intimate the vendor concerned regarding third party inspection by you. Thereafter TPIA shall contact the supplier directly for the purpose of inspection.
- c) After receipt of call from suppliers, TPIA shall normally carry out inspection of materials as early as possible but within 3-4 days at supplier's place. Any delay shall be intimated to us.
- d) All relevant certificates shall be collected from the supplier before giving your report and dispatch advice to the vendor. These Certificates should be sent to HOCL along with your inspection records & Timesheets in soft copies within 48 hrs.
- e) Wherever TPI agency have given approval for dispatch of inspected materials from vendor's site and subsequently we find that the materials do not conform to specifications, you shall be responsible for getting off-specification materials replaced by the vendor and also the inspection charges for such items will not be paid.
- f) The inspection report (IR) shall essentially contain following details:

1. Price:

- i. You may please submit your detailed offer for carrying out the Third Party Inspection works on "rate per day" basis.
- ii. For any outstation Inspection, Please offer your rates for rendering services on per day basis inclusive of travel and accommodation.
- iii. The prices shall remain firm during validity period of service contract. No price variation clauses is admissible. The price shall be all inclusive of all other charges such as taxes, transport, accommodation and other incidental charges.
- iv. The bidder has to quote as per the price formats given. The bidders who has submitted prices in any other forms shall be rejected.
- 2. <u>Period of Contract</u>: Period of contract would be for two year from the date of placement of order. Rates shall be firm for a period of 2 Year
- 3. The bid shall contain as integral part of the same the following compliance statement: "We have read, understood and accepted the terms and conditions of purchase and related documents forming part of this enquiry and agree to supply the goods in compliance with the same."
