| Cargo | Phenol (Carbolic Acid) | UN No. 1671 |
| Nature of Hazard | Usually Colourless liquid with Perceptible odour Highly toxic Corrosive Very rapid severe poisoning perhaps fatal by contact with skin Causes Severe damage to eyes and skin Inflammable (flash point above 55°C but not exceeding 100°C) | |
| Protective Devices | Goggles giving complete protection to eyes. Apron or other light protective clothing, boots and plastic or rubber gloves. Bottle with polyethylene glycol Eyewash bottle with clean water | |

EMERGENCY ACTION

Notify Police and Fire Bridage Immediately

Stop the Engine
No naked lights. No Smoking
Mark roads and warn other road users.
Keep public away from danger area

Spillage

Prevent substance entering sewers
Cover spilled substance - consult an expert
Do no flush road with water
If substance has entered a water course or sewer or contaminated soil or vegetation, advise police.

Fire

Extinuish with dry chemical foam or water spray if possible.
Prevent water running into sewers.
Keep upwind.

Fire Aid

If the substance has got into the eyes. immediately wash out with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes.
Immediately rip of all contaminated clothing
Immediately wash or drench affected skin with large quantities of water, swabbing continously and or / swab Continously with polyethylene glycol
Continue treatment changing swabs frequently until the odour of phenol disappears.
Seek medical treatment when anyone has symptoms apparently due to contact with skin or eyes or inhalation
